

TITLE: Rail Operator

REPORTS TO: Rail Foreman

POSITION PURPOSE/SUMMARY:

This person's primary responsibility is railcar loading of High-Quality Frac Sand at the Rail Load-out site in Humbird, WI.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operates facility loading thousands of tons of Frac Sand into railcars per day.
- Railcar inspection of defects and/or contamination, including cleaning of railcars.
- Inspection/cleaning of rail tracks and switches
- Monitors outputs and communicates info to on-site Foreman and Hixton Operation
- Operates locomotive and track mobile equipment to maneuver railcars
- Perform Minor Maintenance on operation including to, but not limited to, greasing, scale calibrations, conveyor maintenance
- Inspect, identify, and implement fixes on any safety hazards that may arise in work place.
- Manage parts inventory levels and communicates level to Foreman/Management.
- Maintains housekeeping in work place and rail yard
- Must be self-motivated and flexible
- Performs other related duties as needed

WORKING CONDITIONS

Work is performed in outside, sometimes wet, environment and frequently climb stairs. Employee may be subject to changing weather conditions, lifting objects up to 50 lbs, minor heights, and non-hazardous chemicals.
